Don't be the person who already knows how long it takes to get from your house to the church, but leaves too late to have that amount of time available - and still prays that God will get you there on time! God doesn't work like that!



Edgar Cayce was able to sleep on a book and know its contents when he awoke. I seriously doubt that any of us can do that! We must put in the time and effort to get our goals accomplished. Michael J. Fox could simply read over his script one time for the next day's rehearsal and know it by heart! If you can do that - or something comparable - more power to you. However, it you need to put in a reasonable amount of effort to get what you want accomplished, know that you will have to put in the right amount of effort to get that done.

There are things we all want, but some of them we want more than others. Some of them we just don't want enough to spend the time and effort on. We also can't do everything, so we must decide what is most important and apply ourselves to that goal. Each of us gets 365 days in 2026. How will you use those days? No complaining if you have not put in the effort!


