from the pastor

Dear Friend,

What does it mean to be a disciple of Jesus Christ? I suspect that I could ask a hundred people this question and end up with a hundred different answers. Well, maybe not a hundred, but the truth is few Christians today

truly understand what it means to be a disciple. For too long the church has focused on making members over making disciples. Likewise, we have concentrated on making committee members over ministers, and building buildings over building communities. It is time that we get our priorities straight.

The mission of the United Methodist Church is to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. It is not to recruit new members, raise more money, or build new buildings. These things may need to happen but only in service to the mission.

The mission is to make disciples, recruiting new members,

raising money, and building buildings, are to be understood as means, and are not to be confused with the mission the end of which is the transformation of the world.

As United Methodist Christian we are called to make a difference. In the Acts of the Apostles, Jesus followers are described as people who are turning the world upside down. Wherever the gospel was preached, lives were being transformed, whole communities were changing. Borders and boundaries dissolved in the living water of God's truth. We are the heirs of this Apostolic tradition, the tradition of bringing live enriching change to communities of people. Disciples of Jesus Christ are transformers, are people who by the grace given to them change lives for the better.

The question, I have been asking myself, and now put before you, is this: how is Trinity UMC making a difference in our community. If tomorrow the church were suddenly gone, what difference would it make to our community? I am asking each of you to pray about these questions. How are we being called to make disciples? How are we empowering disciples to transform the world? I encourage you to talk with one another. Share what you believe God is telling you and listen to how God may be speaking to others. Then together let us act. Together we can make disciples for the transformation of the world.


