a letter from the pastor



Dear Friends,

In his sermon, “The Means of Grace,” John Wesley tells his listeners that the aim of real religion is being purified from pride, anger, and evil desire, through faith in the power of God. Another way of saying the same thing is to say the goal of real religion is holiness of heart and mind. The question is how does one become holy and purified from pride, anger, and evil desire?

From the very beginning, the Church has taught that “Jesus ordained certain outward means for conveying inner grace into our souls.” Included in these ordinary means of grace are constant prayer, (both individual and corporate), the sacraments of baptism and the Lord’s Supper, and the study of Scripture. The regular use of these means of grace is essential to achieving the aim of the Christian faith. Holiness of heart and mind can be achieved only through regular prayer, study, and worship.

With this in mind, I would like to invite each of you to join me this summer in a season of prayer for Trinity United Methodist Church and for the community of San Antonio, Texas. I invite each of you to schedule a set time each day to pray. Ask that God’s grace fall upon this community in a new and powerful way. Listen for God’s leading, then act

Second, I would like to invite each of you to join in our summer Bible study on the Revelation. Many people are intimidated by the highly symbolic language of the Revelation, and consequently avoid the book altogether. By so doing, they miss out on the beautiful message contained within it. If you are already familiar with the book, I believe that this time of corporate study will help you to deepen your understanding of the text, which will then help you draw nearer to God. If the Revelation is new to you, then I can guarantee an eye-opening experience. The Revelation is not what most people think it is. Classes will meet on Monday evening at 6:30 and Tuesday mornings at 11:00 beginning on June 19th. We expect to take six weeks to complete our study.

If you are interested in doing a particular study in the future, please contact me and let me know what you have in mind. I hope that this will be a profitable summer for you and that you will be blessed through the intentional use of the means of grace.


