Testament, the New Testament, and the Gospel. There's a psalm for the morning and a psalm to read in the evening. There're also readings for Sunday's lectionary. These are the same scriptures read by Christians all over the world each Sunday. Bottom line: join me in asking God how we can grow in relationship with Him.

Feel free to join the prayer team Tuesdays at 1:30 in the Null building. You can join us regularly or visit periodically.


