Lent is the Christian season of preparation before Easter. It is a special time of prayer, repentance, sacrifice and good works. In Western Christianity, Ash Wednesday marks the first day, or the start of the season of Lent, which begins 40 days prior to Easter (Sundays are not included in the count).

WHAT ARE YOU GIVING UP FOR LENT?

The Lenten season is upon us. As you all know, it is a time of self-denial and reflection. Technically it is a time of fasting, but I don't believe that fasting, per se, gets us closer to God. If that works for you, go for it! We must be mindful of WHY we are fasting or giving up anything.

In our last worship meeting we decided to ask members to give up some of their personal time and give it to someone else. In other words, use time you would normally allocate to watching T.V. or to going to a movie or to reading a book or jogging to doing something thoughtful for someone else. After all, we were put on this earth to help others. Instead of spending your day in self-indulgent activities, why not volunteer somewhere or visit someone in a hospital or nursing home or even on the streets where our homeless live? These visits may be the only ones those people ever get. Every time I have visited someone in a hospital or nursing home, I always get a "thank you for coming." So far, I have not had the courage to visit those living on the streets, but I believe there are some of you who do have this courage.

Maybe you could cook a meal for someone unable to cook for himself. At least, you could place a phone call to someone who is no longer able to attend services here. Give up some of your T. V. time for that person. Plan on 30 minutes to an hour per call! These people are generally lonely, so any phone call will probably last as long as they can make it.

I know very well that all of us are busy. I also know that many of us no longer have the energy we once had. Obviously, that is one big reason this would be a sacrifice. You will have to follow your heart and conscience to decide what you can and are willing to do. I ask only that you think seriously about it.
